**Philatelic Auctioneers Standard Terms and Conditions of Sale shall apply.**

The highest bidder shall be the successful purchaser, where 2 bids of the same amount are received, the earliest shall be the buyer.

Buy bids are not accepted, bids below the stated reserve price shall not be accepted.

Lots purchased are the responsibility of the purchaser at the fall of the hammer and will be sent by post to absentee bidders by Royal Mail at the buyers own risk using the most appropriate Royal Mail service, solely at the cost of the purchaser.

There is no buyers premium or VAT chargeable on any lot in the auction.

Postal bids will be entered by the auctioneer who shall bid on their behalf and whilst every care will be taken in exercising postal bids, neither the Society or its Officers may be held liable for any errors, omissions or mistakes.

Bidding steps: the following bidding steps should be used:

£1 - £20 at £1 steps  
£20 - £50 at £2 steps  
£50 - £200 at £5 steps  
£200 above at £10 steps

These steps can be varied at the auctioneer discretion.

All bids should be in GB£, bids not matching the above bidding steps will be rounded down to the next step.

Payment shall be by cash, cheque or via Paypal only.

Non members of the Society who are successful in purchasing one or more lots shall pay an additional sum of £12.50 for one year's electronic membership of the society, effective from the date of the auction.

Absentee buyers are required to pay for their lots together with the postage and packing charge before lots are posted.
